



Safety Visionary Award Criteria

The **Safety Visionary Award** honors **one individual annually** who demonstrates exceptional leadership and dedication to advancing safety within their organization and the industry. This award recognizes a person who goes **above and beyond** in fostering a culture of safety, protecting their team, and inspiring lasting change.

Nominees should meet the following criteria:

1. Leadership in Safety Culture

- Actively promotes safety as a core value within their team or organization.
- Champions proactive safety practices and continuous improvement.

2. Innovative Safety Solutions

- Develop or implement innovative practices, policies, or technologies that enhance workplace safety.
- Shows creativity in solving safety-related challenges.

3. Mentorship and Engagement

- Serves as a mentor or role model in safety, encouraging peer accountability and shared responsibility.
- Engages and empowers team members to actively participate in safety programs.

4. Outstanding Safety Performance

- Demonstrates a consistent and measurable record of safety excellence (e.g., incident reduction, audit success, safety training completion).
- Goes beyond standard job responsibilities to advocate for safety improvements.

5. Long-Term Impact

- Creates a lasting positive impact on safety culture that benefits current and future team members.
- Recognized by peers and leadership as a driving force in organizational safety.

Eligibility:

- Nominees must be part of an organization that participates in the Safety Awards program.
- Only one individual is selected each year for this distinction.

The candidate must meet the criteria mentioned above for consideration. Once all the applications have been reviewed by MTBMA's Safety Committee their respective companies will be notified. An awards banquet will be held for all award recipients to attend and be recognized by their family, other award winners, company representatives, and other distinguished guests.
